

About Backdrop The Drupal Fork

- Forked from D7, actually early D8
- Simple, lightweight and easy to use CMS
- For professional and comprehensive websites
- Less backward-looking than many would expect
- Many user interface improvements
- Configuration management, Views, CKEditor, Pathauto, Token, Rabbit Hole, Scheduler, Project Browser, Self Updates ...





- Panels / Panelizer
- Context
- View modes, Display Suite
- Paragraphs
- Theme, Regions + Blocks, Grid systems
- Template files
- D8-10: Layout Builder, Layout Paragraphs

Backdrop Layout

- Backdrop core system
- Layout template + Blocks
- Whole page, incl. header and footer
- For site architects (not editors)



- Add a Layout, choose a context
- Choose a layout template, or build one
- Place and configure your blocks
 - Title
 - Style: classes, markup
 - Visibility
 - Admin info
 - More, dependent of context

Use cases for different Layouts

- Home vs. Default
- Default Admin + Dashboard
- Node content vs. Taxonomy vs. User accounts
- Content types
- Landing pages
- Login page

Useful Modules (There are more.)

- Layout Wildcard
- Copy Blocks
- Mini Layouts



- Accept the Layout system, don't work against it. (You'll love it.)
- Use different Layouts, but not too many.
- Find your own Layout approach.



Backdrop Themes in contrast to Drupal


- No blocks
- No layout
- Just CSS

(plus Theme settings + Template overrides)

Comparison Drupal vs. Backdrop

	Drupal	Backdrop
Layout is	Optional	Required
Layout affects	Main content area	Page
Regions + Blocks	Theme	Layout
Styling	Theme	Theme

- Template code, e.g. Moscone flipped
- Flexible Layout builder
- Content types > Fields
- Existing / hidden path content, e.g. Card
- Login page (e.g. gew)
- 404 (upcoming)
